

Nurse Practitioner Job Description

Position Title: Nurse Practitioner

Schedule: Part-time (3 days per week)

Under Direction of Medical Director but operating in the department run by the Nurse Manager.

Objectives:

The Nurse Practitioner (NP) provides advanced medical care for pregnant mothers and infants under the supervision of the Nurse Manager (RN), serving as a calling to provide Christ-centered care that supports and uplifts families in alignment with the Pregnancy Help Center's mission.

Qualifications:

- 1. Must be a Christian who is committed to carrying out the pro-life mission of the Pregnancy Help Center, recognizing the spiritual and emotional impact this role has on the community.
- 2. Exhibit strong commitment and dedication to the sanctity of all human life.
- 3. Exhibit strong commitment and dedication to sexual purity.
- 4. Agree with and be willing to uphold the Statement of Faith, Statement of Principle, and the policies of the center.
- 5. Hold a valid Nurse Practitioner license with prescriptive authority in the state of operation.
- 6. Ideally have a minimum of two years of clinical experience in maternal and infant care.
- 7. Demonstrate strong interpersonal and patient care skills.
- 8. Ability to work collaboratively within a multidisciplinary team.

Responsibilities:

Patient Care:

- 1. Conduct comprehensive assessments of pregnant mothers and infants, including physical examinations and prenatal checkups.
- 2. Diagnose and manage common prenatal, postpartum, and infant health issues.
- 3. Educate and counsel patients on prenatal care, nutrition, and infant health and wellness.
- 4. Develop individualized care plans for patients and ensure follow-up care as needed.
- 5. Provide medical services in accordance with established protocols, standing orders, and state regulations.



Collaboration:

- 1. Work under the supervision of the Nurse Manager and coordinate care with the Medical Director as needed.
- 2. Collaborate with RNs, sonographers, and other staff members to provide holistic care to clients.
- 3. Participate in team meetings and contribute to the development of medical services at the center.

Administrative Duties:

- 1. Document patient care accurately in medical records and ensure compliance with client regulations.
- 2. Assist with maintaining adequate medical supplies and ensuring medical equipment is properly used and maintained.
- 3. Contribute to the creation and review of educational materials for patients.
- 4. Assist, when necessary, on other tasks or duties required for the running of PHC.
- 5. Assist, when necessary, to fundraising events activities before the event and in attendance.

Continuing Education:

- 1. Comply with state and professional continuing education requirements for Nurse Practitioners.
- 2. Annually review the center's policies and procedures, infection control regulations, and medical protocols.

Evaluation:

The Nurse Practitioner will receive an annual evaluation by the Nurse Manager and Executive Director, focusing on both medical and operational performance.

Key Attributes:

- Compassionate and mission-driven.
- Strong organizational skills with attention to detail.
- Effective communicator with patients and staff.
- Flexible and adaptable to the needs of a dynamic, ministry focused environment.
